REVISED REGION GUIDELINES July 25, 2010
Metro Detroit Regional Service Committee of N.A

Hospitals & Institutions: Shall initiate and unify efforts of Twelve (12) Step work within hospitals and institutions.

Newsletter: Shall assemble, edit, publish and distribute a periodical newsletter.

Outreach: Shall support Area Outreach Subcommittees by being an information exchange for Area Outreach Subcommittees as well as learning and coordinating resource for Area Outreach Subcommittees efforts.

Unity: Shall spearhead discussion and resolution of sensitive issues related to the 1st Tradition, including racism, prejudice, acts and threats of violence, sexual abuse, harassment and other attitudes and/or behaviors that negatively impact the unity of the Fellowship. The goal is to become unified through and with our diversity.

Public Information: Shall initiate and unify efforts of public information and relations inside and outside the fellowship.

Special Events: Shall plan, schedule, set the program and present activities of a special nature or other events as directed by the Committee. It shall also in support of our Fifth (5th) Tradition help coordinate various Area activities and Regional Subcommittee workshops, learning days, etc.

Technology: Shall handle tech things such as regional website and other computer needs that will help carry the message to the addict that still suffers.

Policy Coordinator: The policy coordinator shall determine, write for recommendation and review policy changes for approval of the MDRSCNA, seek guidance in a better understanding of our Traditions and Concepts, and report back to the Region.

Convention: Shall be to provide the fellowship with a local celebration of recovery from addiction and in so doing, help carry the Narcotics Anonymous message by creating collective demonstration of our unity.

Helpline: Shall provide volunteers to answer the phone line and take Twelve (12) step calls, facilitate contact between the addict and the Twelve (12) Step volunteer

Michigan Service Office: provides a number of services to the groups, areas, and the Region. It distributes literature and other items related to Narcotics Anonymous. The office can act as a resource for information on events throughout the Region and can distribute such information with literature orders. The office also provides clerical and administrative support for Regional subcommittees and officers. The Michigan Service Office is supervised and operated by an elected board of directors (BOD) chosen from members of the Metro Detroit Region, individual Area Service committees within the region and one member of the Michigan Region.

Regional Delegate and Regional Delegate Alternate: is the voice of the region, and votes the conscience of the region at the World Service Conference. The primary responsibility of the RD is to work for the good of NA, providing two-way communication between the region and the rest of NA. The RD is the Region's link with Narcotics Anonymous World Services. The RD provides two-way communication between these service levels and the various Areas within their Region and any other Regions.

M.S.O. Report January 2011

Good afternoon Maccomb.

I wish I had some better news to report from the office but unfortunately it is looking a little grim. There was not a convention in November, which in the past bumped up revenue QUITE A Bit . In addition to this we were informed by the DACNA committee that they will not be using any outside vendors in 2011. This is a big blow to the office since we are starting to struggle financially.

This doesn't mean to announce to the fellowship we are closing the doors. We just have to make some pretty tough decisions for office operations. We have currently ceased any more remodeling at this time until our financial situation is better. Some of the items that the board is considering to increase revenue is:

Raise the meeting list \$5 to \$7 (Implement February 1st).
Charge \$5.00 for the creating flyers for groups and areas (right now we do it for free). Increase the charge to the Region for rent to \$200 a month instead of \$75.00 plus \$20.00 for the paper towel and soap. The \$200 would be 10% of our rent which would cover the helpline.

This would raise \$5500.00 a year in added revenue which would offset the current loses the office has incurred. I want to remind everyone the office keeps meeting lists, literature at a minimum cost to the members but we must have enough revenue to cover office operations. As it is now we have board members who come in and work at the office for free to cover the expense of an employee. Many of you have always had the MSO at your disposal for your meeting needs. Yes you can get literature from the World but it is not convenient. You will have to do some future planning to allow enough time to get the merchandise and will not get the personal attention that you do now. We are non-profit, we do make money for the office, we just try to get enough to keep going to serve the fellowship. As I have said in numerous reports submitted, the Michigan office is known around the country for their well stocked and large variety of merchandise. Let's make sure we keep it!!! Offices around the country are struggling even more then we are. We are fortunate to have such a wide variety of merchandise that increases our sales and keeps us going.

Our actual FINANCIALS were as follows:

The sales have continued on a downward trend. Meetings are just not buying literature which may be a result of less money in the baskets. Our total sales for November were \$15,512.83. The last few months have been pretty weak. Literature sales were low at \$12,745.34. Our total income was \$16,376.94. After cost of goods sold the profit was \$4,794.95. After our expenses (6,039.57) we had a net loss of \$1,239.66.

For the first time in five years our office manager is having a difficult time in creating a balanced budget for running the office. The Board will be meeting over the next several months to discuss other options.

For those of you new to the fellowship this may sound like a dreary situation but 5 years ago we had no literature inventory, we were in debt to the WSO and had to pay it off, we had a sales and accounting system that was in disarray and we could not provide an accurate profit and loss statement. There was no shipping system in place, our expenses were ridiculously high, especially payroll which we have cut 27%. We had little merchandise and what we had was unsalable. The back part of the building was nothing more than a garage. We did not have a website and there was little accountability to the fellowship. The success the office has achieved has been due to some of the board members and other members in the fellowship who donated many hours of service, and construction materials to this office, which makes it what it is today. Members have painted, laid carpet, cleaned, broke down boxes, typed meeting list changes, and worked their butts off at conventions to help keep our doors open.

I was asked to convey this information to my area so everyone knows what is at stake here. We cannot change the economic reality of Michigan right now. We cannot force members to put a dollar on the basket so that the groups can continue to operate and buy literature for the newcomer. We cannot force conventions to use us to vend their events.

We are not in at a critical state right now, but if we do not make changes, then it would be too late. We will do whatever is necessary to keep the office open.

I would like to remind our activities chair and sub-committee to please call the office so we can put the events on the activities line. Although I take flyers from here sometimes it is too late. If you email the flyer to the office they can print a few to keep there and I will reimburse them for the printing. The email address is boardmso@sbcglobal.net. The MSO website is www.store.michigan-na.org.

I had all intentions of not coming to the meeting today as I am meeting with my children to celebrate this past holiday. We were unable to meet together prior. I also had not intended on having the willingness to commit to another 3 years as

the Macomb rep. However, as I started writing my report I realized that when I came on the board 3 years ago the office was in a far better place financially. I have been on the board 4th different times in the 24 years I have been around. This is by far the best the office has been managed and it is a result of the conscientious office manager who we have today. It seems to me it would be unfair to leave at such a critical point when there is so much work to do. A board member is only allowed 2 consecutive terms so I have just completed one as the Macomb MSO rep. If the area agrees to seat me again then I will serve another 3 year term. I will warn you however, my work schedule is one that I may miss some area meetings but will always send a report. If you choose not to seat me then I will be seated as an At large seat which means I will still be a board member, I just will not report to you.

I have been involved in area service throughout my time in the fellowship and really think it is important for those of you who show here because this is where your meeting has a voice. In case this is my last month here I want to say to those of you who sponsor people keep your sponsee's involved. To those of you who have sponsors that are not involved... get a new sponsor. Service is important to everyone.
