I am planning to attend the event and in fact I've been asked to be the Sat. night guest speaker. I will also be there Sat. afternoon to assist in the workshops. We did however manage to put the past convention mess behind us. The hotel agreed to waive the remaining balance so in essence, the convention only lost in the neighborhood of \$500.00. However, funding for a future convention seemed in doubt until the hat was passed in the meeting and GSRs coughed up \$200.00 to get things rolling. There is still a quantity of unsold merchandise that should raise a little more and a new convention chair was elected, Patti K, and she has high expectations and big plans once she gets her committee around. Time will be short since the planned date will most likely be in November of this year.

Accountability remains a weak spot in South West. The final convention report consisted of a canvas tote bag with the various records. From what I've been told, large gaps in the check register and an obvious conflict of interest in terms of hiring vendors is apparent. The Area committee is firmly convinced that the HP will take care of them/us and would rather ignore the fact that this convention was a loser and the 2 previous conventions managed to come out even only with last minute anonymous donations. Personally, I feel perhaps the HP has been sending us a message and that as a result of a gargantuan ego in South West, we refuse to listen.

Our Outreach Committee has made tremendous progress after breaking up the Area into districts and getting willingness from members to monitor the various meetings in each district. This way, we can help struggling groups with attendance and find the non-existent groups and get them off the meeting lists.

The R&R at the Fort Committee had a workshop on building strong Home Groups that went very well although attendance was limited due to some nasty weather. Dave T and his son Jake came down from Northwest and spoke and did a fantastic job. Anyone looking for a speaker with a very dynamic message should seriously consider getting Jake to speak at their function. The kid is awesome. The R&R Committee has also gotten their date for this year's Retreat....it'll be August 14-16 in Sturgis Michigan at Camp Fort Hill. Look for fliers soon.
